## Farm to Pharmacy Herbalism Course

### Registration Form

The dates for the course are June 5<sup>th</sup> - July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Classes are held on Fridays from 10:30am - 3:30pm. Additionally, there are two overnight field trips. The class dates include the following: 6/5, (6/12 - 6/14), 6/19, 6/26, (no class on 7/3), 7/10, (7/17 - 7/18), 7/24. The overnight fieldtrips take place on 6/12 - 6/14, and on 7/17 - 7/18.

Students are responsible for providing their own food, transportation, and lodging (including camping fees); as well as for their own food camping supplies for the overnight trips. Students will need to bring lunch and snacks to class on Fridays. There will be a lunch break provided on Fridays.

Students are also required to bring (or purchase) the following supplies which are recommended for this course: Gardening gloves (\$5-\$10), Pruners (\$10-\$60), and a Hory Hory Knife or small digging spade and hand tools (\$5-\$25). The following tools maybe need for some fieldtrips, but are not required: Loppers and a shaving knife/ jack knife. (We will discuss the first day of class.)

The tuition fee is one thousand dollars; it is due on May 21<sup>st</sup>. A two hundred dollar non-refundable deposit is required to hold a space; the remainder of the balance (\$800) is due on May 21<sup>st</sup>.
